The Southern New England Conference ranks first in church plants per member across the entire NAD. Even when compared to much larger fields like Texas with nearly 70,000 members and Carolina with almost 30% more members than us, we still stand third in total new churches planted. This achievement isn't about numbers or competition—it's about the Holy Spirit working through dedicated servants who refuse to accept that any region is too hard for the Gospel.


