The Southern New England Conference ranks #1 in church plants per member! Even when compared to much larger fields — Texas (nearly 70,000 members) and Carolina (almost 30% larger than us) — we still stand #3 in total new churches planted across the entire NAD.

In just three years, God has done something extraordinary through your faithful service:

27 new companies officially organized

16 new churches officially organized

23 mission groups in the process of organization

25 churches revitalized

3,000 baptisms in three years

- -2024 1,245
- 2025 738 (as of October)
